Motion made by Mark Renderman, seconded by Al Bower to approve the 6 month wage rate of \$18.35 for Elizabeth Miller, newly appointed 1st Deputy Register of Deeds per the recommendation of the Executive Committee. Voice vote, all ayes, motion carried.

Motion made by Jerome Krempasky, seconded by Mark Renderman to approve the 18 month wage rate of \$30.05 for the newly hired Clinical Therapist per the recommendation of the Community Services Committee. Voice vote, all ayes, motion carried. Sue Voigt left at 2:47 p.m.

Motion made by Mark Renderman, seconded by Jerome Krempasky to approve increasing the wage of the former Accountant/Payroll and Benefits Coordinator from the starting rate of \$24.66 to the 24 month rate of \$25.96 to match the wage of the newly hired Accountant/Payroll and Benefits Coordinator during the training period effective March 20th, 2016. Voice vote, 3 ayes, 1 nay (Marcia), motion carried. Terri Domaszek left at 2:50 p.m.

Motion made by Al Bower, seconded by Marcia Hochhalter to approve reinstating the practice of hiring LTE flaggers for summer road maintenance at the Highway Department per the recommendation of the Highway Committee. Voice vote, all ayes, motion carried.

Motion made by Mark Renderman, seconded by Jerome Krempasky to change the starting wage of the Clark County Treasurer to \$54,000 and increase the wage by .75% each year for the next four years due to the resignation of the previous County's Treasurer. Voice vote, 3 ayes, 1 nay (Marcia), motion carried.
