Chairperson Hendrickson called the meeting to order at 1:00PM.

Motion by Dale Erickson, second by Jim Hirsch to approve minutes of September 19, 2018 meeting-passed

Discuss Progress on County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update: Chris Straight presented an update on the progress of the planning process including an adjusted timeline for the project and preliminary information regarding Town surveys and meeting with cities/villages. There was discussion regarding the threat analysis and after review it was agreed that the risk and vulnerability values for school and non-school active shooter be elevated. Similar discussion took place regarding wildfire and those values were raised.

Designate Inspector: Motion by Chris Smith, second by Tom Abel to designate Wisconsin Emergency Management as our compliance inspector . This position will be reviewed annually - passed.

Payment process for spill responses: Motion by Tom Abel, second by Dale Erickson to approve payment process for spill responses with no changes - passed.

LEPC by Laws: Motion by Brian Duell, second by Chris Smith to approve the update of the LEPC by Laws - passed

Annual LEPC/EPCRA Press Release: Motion by Brian Duell, second by Dale Erickson to approve annual LEPC/EPCRA press release to be published - passed.

LEPC membership: Members reviewed information list and submitted any updates. Motion by Chris Smith, second by Dale Erickson to amend the membership to remove Greg Herrick and add Scott Haines as well as remove Brian Cockerham and add Dan Dozer. John will forward the updated membership list to Chairman Hendrickson for County Board appointment.

Hazmat Team response in Clark County: Discussion took place regarding hazmat response in Clark County. It is not acceptable to designate the State of Wisconsin contracted teams as the county team. John will be discussing the issue at the Emergency Services Association meeting on April 2nd to see if there is interest in establishing a county team for Clark County. This is an effort that will be worked on and updates shared as available.

Spill Responses: Director Ross reported 3 gas/diesel, 1 mineral oil and 1 milk spill incidents since the last meeting.

County Wide Strategic Plan: Reviewed and changes were discussed. Motion made by Tom Abel to approve the plan as updated, second by Scott Haines- passed
