

Clark County Board of Supervisors  
Economic Development Committee Meeting  
Thursday, June 21, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Fred Schindler at 3:30pm in the offices of CCEDC – Loyal. Present were Fred Schindler, Kevin Flink, Randy Sebesta, and Diane Feiten. Also present were Richard Halopka - Clark County UW Extension Agent, Jane Schmitz - Clark County Rehabilitation & Living Center Director, Bob Meyer, Jerome Krempasky, Greg Glisczinski, Riley Hebert - WCCN, Tim Swiggum (arrived at 3:50), and Sheila Nyberg - Clark County Economic Development Corporation & Tourism Bureau (CCEDC&TB) Executive Director. Discussions on WI Farm Technology Days were held. The possibility of FTD looking at going to a “permanent site” has been floating through the state FTD committee. In 2009, a Clark County Team (and CCEDC&TB) presented a permanent site concept to the State Farm Technology Days Committee. Copies of that presentation were shared. The site identified was owned by Clark County Rehab and Living Center just south of HWY 29. Because of Calumet County backing out of their proposed/commitment to host FTD 2021, there is renewed talk about investigating a “permanent site”.

It was suggested that Clark County form a committee to continue discussions on this topic.
