



## **Confidentiality**

Your attendance at therapy/counseling sessions is held in the strictest confidence bound by state and federal law. The content of your therapy sessions is between you and the therapist. Information concerning therapy is kept in a confidential file and is reviewed only to the extent necessary with other clinic staff for purposes of case supervision. No one outside the department will be informed of your contact with this office without your written permission, except where court ordered services are concerned, where information concerning child abuse/neglect is revealed, where there is duty to warn, or where other exceptions are provided by law. Feel free to ask more about this.

## **Cost of Services**

Most major health insurance companies and medical assistance provide coverage for services received here. If your particular insurance does not cover, or if you have no health insurance, the cost to you will be based on your ability to pay. The Accounting Specialist will assist you in arriving at the actual cost, if you have no insurance.

## **Appointments**

Please keep appointments that you make. If you are unable to keep a scheduled appointment, please cancel the appointment at least 24 hours in advance in order to avoid a charge and so we can offer this time to someone else waiting.

## **Discrimination**
